During the College closure

What are our expectations?

- You should check your emails and Microsoft Teams every day
- Message your form teacher via your form team group every morning to update them on your progress (list of email addresses has been sent out)
- Complete work in line with the deadlines set by your teachers
- Contact your teacher on Microsoft teams chat or via email if you are unsure about the work
- Where possible you should try and follow your school timetable. For example: if you have English on a Monday complete the work set for Monday on Monday. This will save you getting in a muddle or falling behind in a subject
- Please read the remote learning guidance that has also been emailed out

How might your teachers set the work?

- Via Microsoft teams
- Via email

There are a number of ways you will complete work at home

(You will be clearly guided by your subject teacher on what work you have to complete)

- Online learning platforms (suggested by subject teachers such as MyMaths, Kerboodle, etc)
- Completing worksheets
- Doing research
- Writing essays
- Creating presentation

What if you do not meet our expectations?

- Your form teacher will contact your parents
- Your Head of Section or Assistant Head of Section will be informed
- Repeated occurrences of poor work, late work, incomplete work will also be noted and followed up
- You will be sanctioned on return to school
- Don't let yourself, your parents or your teachers down – work with us!
